

## INTERNET ACCESS AGREEMENT - TANNUM SANDS STATE SCHOOL

### DEAR PARENT / GUARDIAN

I understand that the Internet can provide students with valuable experiences.

I also understand that it gives access to information on computers around the world; that the school cannot control what is on these computers; and that a very small part of that information can be illegal, dangerous or offensive.

1. All care will be taken to protect my child and his/her privacy.

3. Full credit will be given to original work.

I accept that while teachers will always exercise their duty of care, protection against exposure to harmful information should depend finally upon responsible use by students.

### STUDENT CONSENT FORM

This document gives the State and Education Queensland permission to use works created by students in the course of their studies for purposes associated with the promotion of Education Queensland or the State of Queensland.

This does not mean that the student, lose ownership rights over the works – simply that Education Queensland has permission to use the works for the purpose mentioned:

1. During the course of student studies provided by Education Queensland, your child may create works which attract intellectual property rights (for example, copyright). These works may form part of academic assessment or studies generally.
2. These works might include written work (eg stories and poems), paintings, pictures, drawings, designs, photographs, videos, films, music, performance, computer programs, web sites, sculptures, fashion or costume, metal or wood works or any other works created.
3. Education Queensland may record sound and/or vision of the student and work whilst at school or taking part in school-related activities or performances.
4. Education Queensland understands that the student owns intellectual property rights in the works, sound and vision, and that this Consent Form is not meant to transfer ownership.
5. I give permission to the State and to Education Queensland to use my child's works, sound/vision, and/or name for:
  - a. the media activity listed on the accompanying schedule which will assist with EQ resource needs
  - b. future media activities which would assist with future curriculum requirements
  - c. promoting and advertising of the State or Education Queensland and its students; and
  - d. any commercial purpose.

I will not withdraw the permission I have given, and Education Queensland understands that I may choose to give this permission to other people.

6. I understand that by giving this permission, Education Queensland can use my child's works, sound and vision any way it chooses, for the purposes described above. It may reproduce them in any form, in whole or in part, and distribute them by any medium including the Internet, CD-Rom, or other multi-media uses.
